## Program Mission

The mission of the EMT-Basic program is to provide an interactive learning environment where students gain confidence and skills needed to become competent EMTs.

## Program Learning Outcomes

Students who successfully complete the EMT-Basic program will be able to:

1. Perform an appropriate patient assessment of the medically ill or physically injured patient in the prehospital setting
2. Obtain a differential diagnosis of the medically ill or physically injured patient utilizing an understanding of anatomy and physiology
3. Formulate an appropriate treatment plan to include appropriate interventions for the medically ill and physically injured patient in the prehospital setting and formulate an appropriate treatment plan to include administration of pharmacological medications for medically ill patients in the prehospital setting
